Second Reading: 2 Corinthians 13:11-13

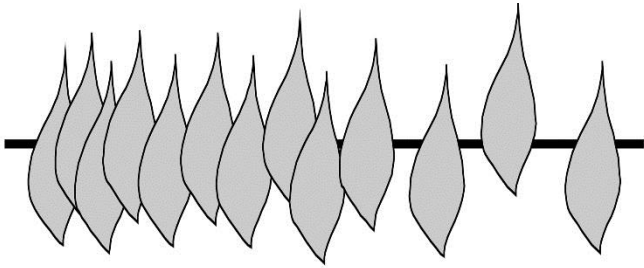
Paul exhorts the Corinthians to live in peace and harmony, and for the first time, invokes the Blessed Trinity.
