### **Second Reading: Colossians 3:1-4**

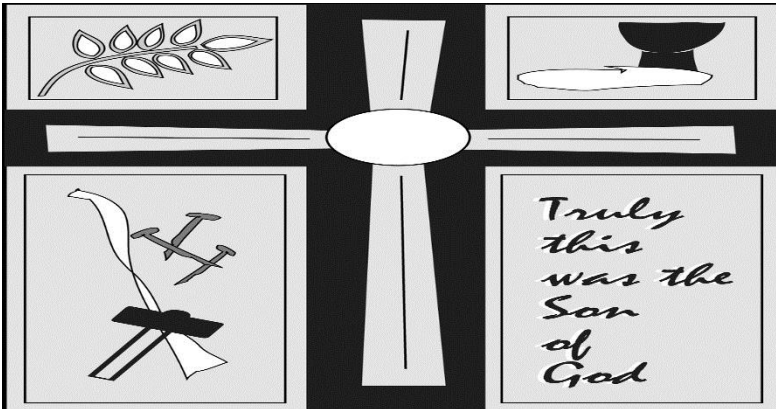
Paul tells the Colossians that they will appear with Christ in glory. They should be mindful of things above rather than things on earth.

# Palm Sunday of the Passion of the Lord

## April 8-9, 2017



“The Lord has given me a well-trained tongue that I may know how to speak to the weary a word that will rouse them... The Lord God is my help, therefore I am not disgraced, I have set my face like flint, knowing that I shall not be put to shame... Rather he emptied Himself.”

Isaiah 50:4-7

With the onset of Holy Week, we walk with Jesus through the saving action He did on our behalf. Because of our need, He became

one with us, took upon Himself our sinfulness and redeemed us.

Holy Week offers us the opportunity to reflect on our ongoing needs, and the continued love of Jesus for us today. We do not just return to the Holy City to remember the special moments of the Paschal Triduum, but we enter into the saving work which Jesus accomplishes in us today.
