**PENTECOST SUNDAY**

**First Reading: Acts 2:1-11**

During the Feast of Pentecost, tongues of fire came to rest on the heads of the disciples and they were filled with the Holy Spirit. Each disciple began speaking in a different language, and were understood by people from many different regions who were amazed at what they had witnessed.

**Second Reading: 1 Corinthians 12:3b-7, 12-13**

Paul explains that we are all members of one body. We have all been baptized in one Spirit and although numerous, we are one through Christ.

**Gospel: John 20:19-23**

John describes Jesus' first visit to the disciples after his resurrection. He gave them the Holy Spirit and the power to forgive other people or hold them responsible for their actions.

# Seventh Sunday of Easter

“Peter stood up in the midst of the brothers...He said ‘My brothers, the Scriptures had to be fulfilled which the Holy Spirit spoke beforehand...it is necessary that one of the men who accompanied us the whole time the Lord Jesus came and went among us, beginning from the baptism of John until the day he was taken up from us, become with us a witness of his resurrection.’ Then they prayed, ‘You, Lord, who know the hearts of all, show which one of these two you have chosen.’”

Acts 1:15-17, 20a, 20c-26

Reading the Acts of the Apostles we are constantly reminded of the role and the power of the Holy Spirit. The group of eleven and their companions depended on the grace and

power of the Spirit to direct them in their new found mission. In sports language, the Holy Spirit was the twelfth person on the field. They knew they needed outside help.

It is no different today. The church calls us all to ministry, some ordained, some consecrated, all dedicated to the building of His kingdom. The Spirit speaks to you as you read today, expressing the need as well as the call. We too pray ‘Oh, Lord, you know my heart, show me what you want me to do for your church.’
